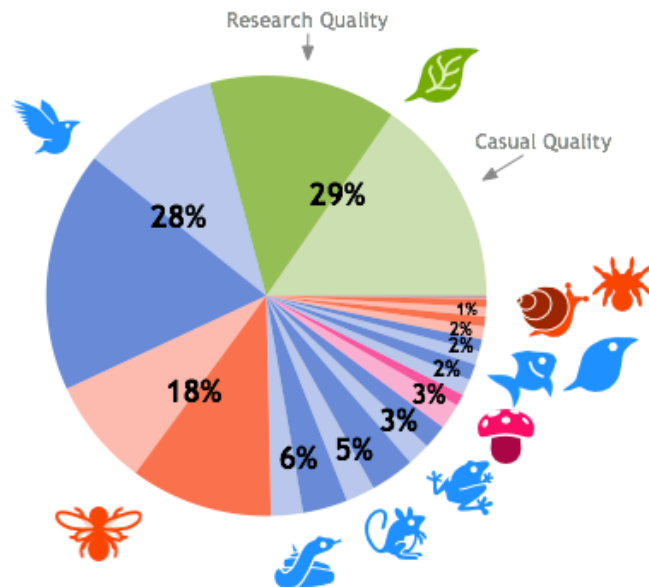

We passed 500,000 observations today! Just under half of these (49%) are research quality. You can check out the portion (~188k) that has been archived in the [Global Biodiversity Information Facility](#) [here](#). 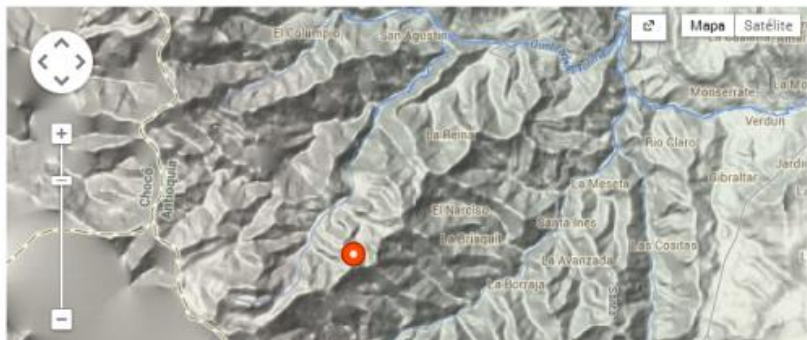
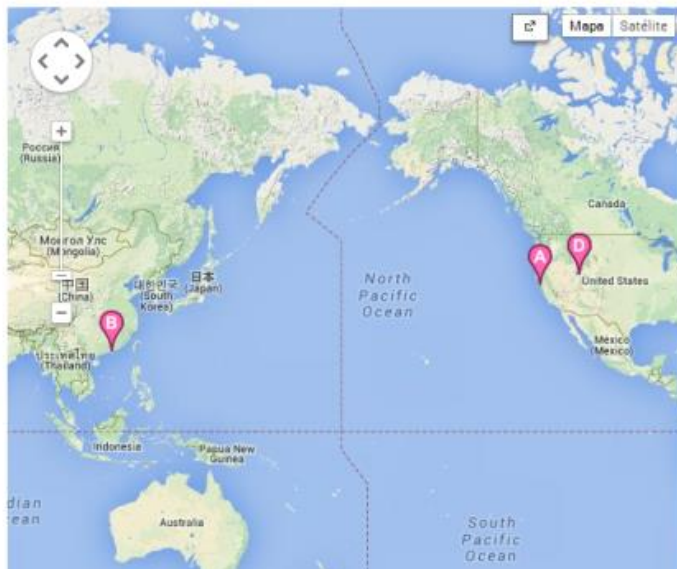

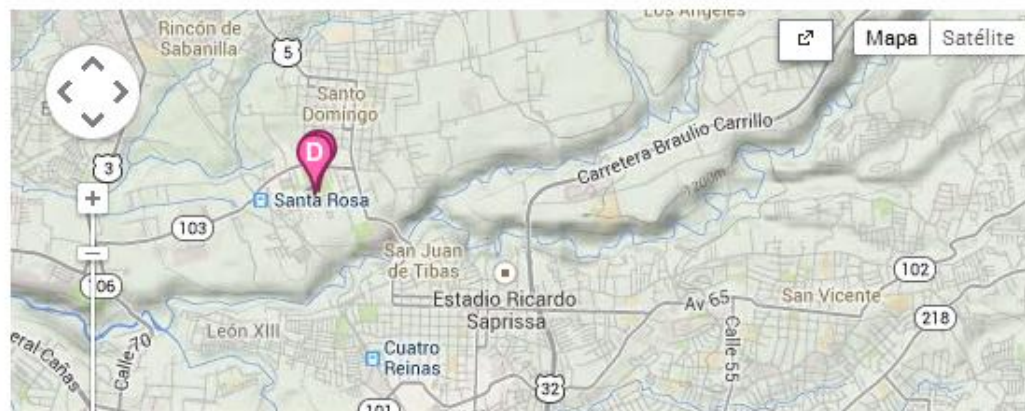

Data Quality Assessment

About the Quality Assessment

The data quality assessment is a summary of an observation's accuracy. All observations start as "casual" grade, and achieve "research" grade when

- the iNat community agrees with the observer's ID, where an "agreeing" identification is one that matches exactly or is of a child taxon of the observer's ID. For example, if Scott says it's a mammal and Ken-ichi says it's *Homo sapiens*, then Ken-ichi agrees with Scott.
- the observation has a date
- the observation is georeferenced (i.e. has lat/lon coordinates)
- the observation has photos or sounds

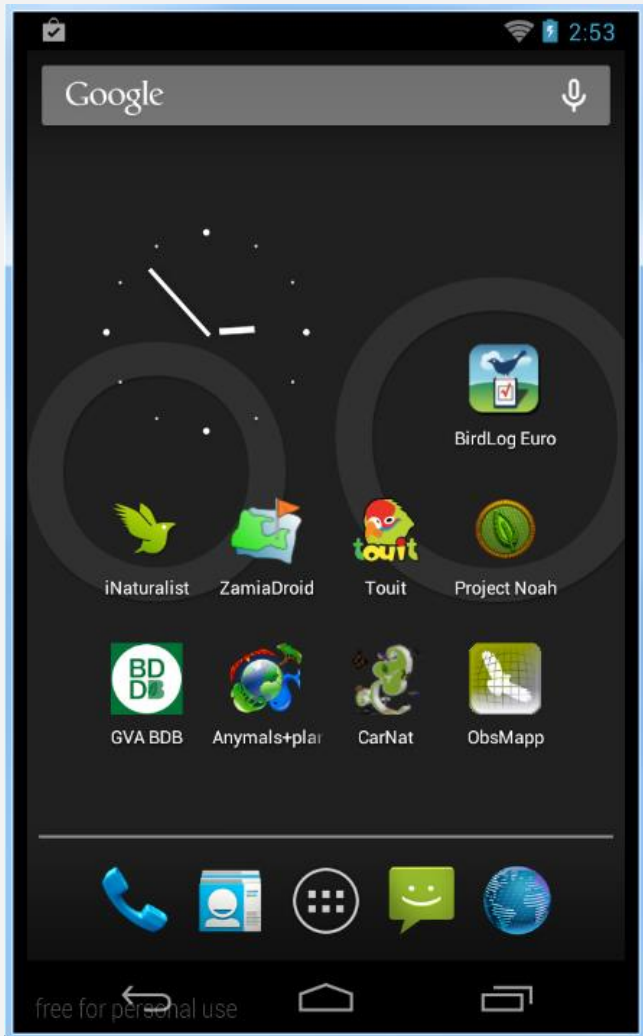
Observations will revert to "casual" grade if the above conditions aren't met or

- the community agrees the location doesn't look accurate (e.g. monkeys in the middle of the ocean, hippos in office buildings, etc.)
- the community agrees the organism isn't wild/naturalized (e.g. captive or cultivated by humans or intelligent space aliens)
